Detail Itinerary

Day 1: A helicopter ride to Everest Base camp

Early morning, you will head to the Kathmandu domestic airport to catch the helicopter flight. The helicopter takes off from the airport at 6:00 a.m. to Lukla airport. Our helicopters will provide you with comfortable seats and large glass windows to sit and enjoy the magnificent panoramic view of the mountains. You will admire the beautiful views of the mountain ranges like Mount Ganesh Himal, Manaslu, Langtang, and Jugal Himal through the windows.

The closer you get to Lukla, you will see Sherpa villages and the aura of their Buddhist tradition. All of these rich and vibrant places will please your heart.

The helicopter stops at Lukla to refuel. After this short break in Lukla, you will arrive in Pheriche. Then the helicopter will carry 2 or 3 people (depending on weight) and head to Kala Patthar.

While heading towards Kala Patthar, the helicopter flies over the gorges of the Dudh Kosi River. This gorge is carved by two towering peaks of the Everest region, namely Kwangde and Kusum Kanguru, with Thamserku peaks.

The helicopter will then proceed to Mt. Everest Tengboche Base Camp. As the helicopter flies over the beautiful Khumbu Valley, it will land at Kala Patthar (5,545 meters). Kala Patthar is a lovely destination near Gorak Shep to see the mountains of the Everest region.

Stopping at Kala Patthar for 5-10 minutes, you will observe the majestic view of Mount Everest (8,848 m) in the closest part. In addition to that, you will enjoy the view of the ice falls, glaciers, and other adjacent peaks.

After a stop at Kala Patthar, you will fly to Everest Base Camp. You will have a great view of the Khumbu Icefall and glaciers from the helicopter over Everest Base Camp.

After this remarkable helicopter ride over Everest base camp, you will go to Pheriche. The helicopter will drop people off and take the rest of the people on a trip to Kala Patthar and Everest base camp.

When Chopper finishes his trip to Kala Patthar, it will return to Everest Base Camp again and take everyone together to Everest View Hotel for breakfast lunch. After breakfast or lunch, you will return Lukla and to Kathmandu with a heart full of memories of the heavenly place.

Itinerary

First part: Early in the morning around 5–6 a.m., we will transfer you to Kathmandu National Airport. From Kathmandu, you will take a flight to Lukla, the gateway to Mount Everest and Sherpa villages.

Second Part: From Lukla, you will head towards Everest Base Camp, where the helicopter will fly over Namche, Tengboche, Pheriche, and Lobuche.

Third Part: helicopter will stop at the Kala Pattar Heliport for approximately 10 minutes. It is to allow your body to adapt to the changing pressure, from where you will see the 360 panoramas of Mount Everest, the Khumbu Glacier, and Himalayas range

Fourth part: From Kalapathar, you will stop at Syangboche near Everest view Hotel for breakfast. Syangboche is the best place for an excellent view of Mount Everest and its ranges.

Fifth part: From Syangboche, you will return to Lukla. Depending on the flight schedule, you can arrive in Lukla before noon.

Sixth Part: From Lukla, you will fly to Kathmandu. Our vehicle will be waiting for you at the domestic terminal of Kathmandu to receive and transfer to your hotel.

Acclimatization

During your helicopter excursion to Everest base camp, you will fly from Kathmandu at 1300 meters to a maximum altitude of 5545 meters in a few hours. Rapidly increasing height can lead to acute mountain disease (MMS). Therefore, you have to be very careful. You can take the Diamox tablet as a precaution before you start the trip. It is also recommended to consult your doctor before booking the trip.

The perfect time for a helicopter tour to Everest Base Camp

Although the weather in the Everest region varies from season to season, you don't have to avoid having this pleasant experience. As it is a few hours, you can have your flight around the reason for Everest if the weather is beautiful at this particular time. We cannot operate your flight on a rainy or foggy day. There is no point in having a flight because you cannot observe the scenario correctly. It is not appropriate to go there, given your safety as well.

Spring and fall seasons are usually best suited to have a flight to Everest. In these seasons, the weather is evident and sunny. Humidity is low, and the chance of rain is also meager. In winter, you can sometimes have misty weather, but on beautiful winter days, it is the best time to have the Heli Tour. During the winter, the snow thickens by a few centimeters, increasing the beauty of the Himalayas to the next level and complementing the crystal clear sky. In summer, the mountains face heavy rains most of the day; it is the least suitable season to take off. However, you can have a helicopter ride in bright climates. One thing you have to keep in mind is that, during the summer, the weather can turn the other way in a few seconds.
